

2007 Instructional (Tee-Ball) League Bylaws

- 1) Players MUST bat off of a tee.
- 2) The entire team shall take the field.
- 3) There will be no standings or scorekeeping in the Instructional League.
- 4) No strikeouts, base stealing or base leading is allowed.
- 5) Game length will be no more than 3 innings or 90 minutes.
- 6) Teams will utilize the “continuous batting order” rule. The inning is over when all players on both teams have batted.
- 7) Base runners may not advance due to overthrown balls.
- 8) Only the League President or the Instructional Director can cancel games due to inclement weather or other circumstances.
- 9) Both teams playing are responsible for field maintenance.
- 10) Spectators are prohibited from standing behind the backstop or at the dugout at any time.
- 11) No food is allowed in the dugout or bench areas. Drinks in proper, safe containers are allowed.
- 12) Disruption of the game, arguments between coaches and umpires or parents and any other volunteers is prohibited. These types of situations will be handled in a “Zero Tolerance” manner. Anyone becoming unruly or using inappropriate language, gestures or actions is subject to league sanctions. This includes immediate ejection from the park or dismissal pending a hearing of the matter.
